My commitment to the betterment of my educational communities has been a life long passion.While completing my combined Honours Bachelor of Social Work and Women's Studies degree at the University of Windsor, I was the Vice President of the Women and Gender Studies Student Association. In this role I planned social events, organized a yearly publication and participated in meetings with professors to discuss educational opportunities and advocate for the needs of students. Additionally, I was also employed as a Teaching Assistant in the fourth year of my degree at the University of Windsor and a Graduate Assistant while completing my education at King's University College at Western University for my Masters of Social Work degree. My experiences as a Teaching Assistant and Graduate Assistant allowed me the opportunity to better understand the roles and responsibilities of educators. During my time at Western University, in addition to being employed as a Graduate Assistant, I participated in the Social Work Week committee as a Student Representative. This experience allowed me to not only garner the skills of collaboration and financial acuity, but also skills to inform decision making to meet the wants and needs of my educational community.

My commitment to community engagement and support for public education endured beyond my educational career. In between my University degrees, I always found a way to stay engaged within the public education system and my community at large. In Toronto, I volunteered in Public School classrooms and In Windsor, I volunteered for the Windsor Essex branch of the Canadian National Institute for the Blind and worked as a Support Worker at Family Respite Services Windsor Essex. These volunteer and employment experiences fostered a sense of compassion and empathy for vulnerable populations. This compassion and empathy is a driving force for my desire to be a school board trustee and ensure that school environments are safe, supportive and accessible for all students.

Creating supportive and trusting relationships, advocacy and social justice are hallmarks of my career as a Registered Social Worker. Currently, I work as a Social Worker in private practice where I provide social work services, counselling and psychotherapy to individuals 13 and up. My practice is located at the intersection of Tecumseh and Howard, situated within the boundaries of Ward 3 and 4. Prior to opening my private practice, I worked at the Sexual Assault Crisis Centre of Essex County where I provided intake, counselling and community outreach services to survivors of sexual violence. Working within the wards I am hoping to represent provides me with particular insight into the needs of the community. Public education touches the lives of all community members whether it is through their own education or employment, through family members or people they interact with on a daily basis in their social lives.
