History Corner – Old Windsor City Hall



The site of the hall was previously Central Public School, thereafter the city purchased the property in 1904 and served it as the city hall. In 1955, construction began on a new building that was completed in 1956 at a cost of \$2.1 million. In 2005, an additional structure of the Windsor City Hall campus opened across the street from the main building, at 400 City Hall Square.
