

French Immersion

Sandwich Secondary School offers a full French Immersion Program and an extended French Immersion Program. In the full French Immersion Program students accumulate ten credits in French; four are in FSL (French as a Second Language) courses and six are in other subjects where French is the language of instruction. In the extended French Immersion Program students accumulate seven credits in French, four are in FSL courses and three are in other subjects where French is the language of instruction.

The GECDSB currently offers the DELF exam (Diplôme d'études en langue française) to students enrolled in Grade 12 French courses in both French Immersion programs as well as the core French program. The DELF exam is an assessment of proficiency in French offered through the Ministry of National Education in France.

Enhanced Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program (OYAP)

The Enhanced OYAP is a program that enables students to learn a skilled trade while completing the requirements for their Ontario Secondary School Diploma. The program begins in grade 11 and involves in-depth technical training in the classroom combined with experiential learning within the trade for 12 months. Students enrolled in the Enhanced OYAP register with the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities as an apprentice who administers and regulates the program. At Sandwich Secondary School we offer Enhanced OYAP in **Precision Metal Cutting**. For more information, visit

Specialist High Skills Majors (SHSM)

Specialist High Skills Majors let students focus on a career path that matches their skills and interests. They are comprised of a bundle of 8-10 credits including a cooperative education experience. In addition, multiple compulsory and elective certifications will be earned in areas such as CPR, First Aid, WHMIS, Fork Lift Training, and Customer Service. At Sandwich Secondary School, we offer an SHSM in **Aviation**, **Business**, **Construction**, **Health & Wellness** and **Manufacturing** (with a Precision Metal Cutting or Robotics option). 

All Feeder School students (those students that will complete GRADE 8 from Amherstburg PS, Bellewood PS, James L Dunn PS, LaSalle PS, Legacy Oak Trail PS or Sandwich West PS)-you will be visited at your elementary school by our guidance counsellors at the end of January with registration packages to take home to parents/guardians.

For any GECDSB public board students completing Grade 8 at other public board schools in Windsor-Essex: If you wish to attend Sandwich Secondary School instead of your designated home secondary school, please contact your current elementary school at the beginning of January to complete an Out of District application. Once approved, you will be contacted and a registration package will be provided.
