### 17 Compulsory Credits

## STUDENTS MUST EARN THE FOLLOWING COMPULSORY CREDITS TO GET THEIR ONTARIO SECONDARY SCHOOL DIPLOMA (OSSD):

- 4 credits in English (1 credit per grade)
- 3 credits in mathematics (at least 1 credit in Grade 11 or 12)
- 2 credits in science
- 1 credit in Canadian geography (Grade 9)
- 1 credit in Canadian history (Grade 10)
- 1 credit in the arts
- 1 credit in health and physical education
- 1 credit in French as a second language
- 0.5 credit in career studies
- 0.5 credit in civics and citizenship
  - 1 credit in technological education (Grade 9 or Grade 10)
  - 1 credit from the STEM-related course group

## OF THE 17 COMPULSORY CREDITS, YOU MUST COMPLETE ONE FROM THE FOLLOWING STEM-RELATED COURSE GROUP:

- business studies
- computer studies
- cooperative education
- mathematics (in addition to the 3 compulsory credits)
- science (in addition to the 2 compulsory credits)
- tech. education (in addition to the 1 compulsory credit)
